The sudden unforeseen changes have highlighted that we may have to be more imaginative with our Mass times next year to make sure we can cover Holy Souls and St Norbert's with one priest, giving us a little bit of flexibility to help across the Deanery.

the Blessed Sacrament as we prepare for the Eucharistic Congress in Liverpool in September. I would strongly encourage you to pray for an increase in vocations to the Priesthood during this year. In our Diocese, God willing, we will have three Ordinations to the Priesthood this year but that will leave us with only two men in the seminary once the ordinations have happened. So we certainly need to be praying and encouraging people to consider the vocation to priesthood.

The low number of people training means that in the coming years we will have fewer priests so more compromises will have to take place to continue to offer the Sacraments across the Diocese.

The start of the new year also sees many of the priests taking a well-earned post-Christmas break with Fr

Emmanuel away for the next few weeks; so a little prayer for me would be verv welcome.

I pray that you and your families have a Blessed and Holy 2018.
