Peoples Ponderings

Last weekend we celebrated the Feast of Corpus Christi, the Feast reminds us of the importance of the Eucharist and of coming to Mass every Sunday (or Saturday Vigil). In his pastoral letter to the Diocese of St Andrew's and Edinburgh, Archbishop Cushley stressed the importance of the Sunday Mass obligation. He commented on how attending Mass on a Sunday is 'a solemn and binding obligation, and if we deliberately fail in this matter, it is a grave sin and we must go to confession before receiving communion again'.

This has been the long-standing teaching of the Church but like many things over the years, there seems to have been an element of ignoring it. Mass shouldn't be something we do, when there is nothing better to do, or something that we attend once a month or even just at Christmas and Easter. Christ is not someone who should be competing with other activities. Spending time with the Lord once a week is surely the least we can do for our Saviour.

It is important to remember that the Sunday Obligation doesn't mean that the Church expects you to come off your sick bed to attend Mass. However missing Mass because family or friends are visiting or because it clashes with a sporting activity, is not okay. We must make sure that God is given the priority that He deserves and is not seen as a nice extra every now and then.
