## Changes to Mass Times (Holv Souls)

Last weekend it was announced that Fr Emmanuel would be leaving Holy Souls and St Norbert's. This move has not come as a surprise and as a Deanery we have been considering the impact losing him would have on the number of Masses that can be offered. At the previous Deanery meeting the following changes were agreed and will become *effective from the first weekend in September (Saturday 1st/Sunday 2nd):* agreed and will become effective from the first weekend in September (Saturday 1st/Sunday 2nd):

 ⇒ Weekends – we will no longer have a Saturday Vigil Mass at Holy Souls; the Vigil Mass at St Bernadette's will be moved to 6.00 pm.
 ⇒ Weekday Masses at Holy Souls on Tuesday and Friday will be at the new time of 8.30 am, allowing me enough time to get to St Norbert's for Mass at 10.00 am.
 ⇒ There will be no weekday Mass at Holy Souls on a Thursday (except for Holy Days of Obligation)
 It is never easy to make changes to Mass times, let alone to remove a Mass completely. I hope that people appreciate that we must look outside of our own Parish boundary and do what is best for the area as a whole. whole.

It is felt that one Saturday evening Mass is enough for the numbers that attend in Scunthorpe. As Holy Souls also has a Sunday Evening Mass, it was felt best to keep the vigil Mass at St Bernadette's. This means that the two parishes in Scunthorpe have two Sunday Masses.
The cancelation of the evening Mass at Holy Souls allows us to continue the evening Mass at St Thomas's, Gainsborough. This was important due to the distance they are away from another Parish. **The Saturday evening Mass at Winterton will only continue if Fr Wlodek is able to do it.**I will now move my day off to a Thursday (rather than a Wednesday) to ensure that there is a weekday Mass in Scunthorpe throughout the week, as Mgr Tom goes to Gainsborough on a Wednesday. We made changes this year to the Holy Week Mass times and I believe that these will be workable next year with the help of Deacon especially on Good Friday.
