Planned redecoration of Church

As has been mentioned before, the Parish has been left various legacies over recent years to go towards redecoration of the Church. We have now received a first design from our architects which can be seen on the notice board next to the Repository. The design shows plans to replace the carpet with tiling and to add new artwork around the stained glass windows. We will also be looking to tidy up the area where the organ is situated. In addition to this work we are also considering putting painted decoration on the timber beams to match the ones over the sanctuary and to add a painted decoration around the Rose window at the western end. These works all come within our budget and will complement the work done on the Sanctuary during Canon John Cahill's time. Any feedback on the proposals would be welcomed.
