Peoples' Ponderings

This week marked the 50th Anniversary of Blessed Paul VI encyclical Humanae Vitae. It is without doubt one of the most controversial documents issued by a Pope and to this day many people have strong opinions about it. I had hoped to share more of the insights of the document during the year (but I have got in to the rhythm of writing ponderings!). It is worth remembering the three consequences of the use of artificial contraception that he predicted 50 years ago!

- It will open the way for marital infidelity and a general lowering of moral standards.
- A man who grows accustomed to the use of a contraceptive method may forget the reverence due to a woman and reduce her to being an instrument for the satisfaction of his own desires.
- The state may impose the use of contraceptive methods on everyone, thus intervening in the most personal and intimate responsibility of husband and wife.

Whatever people may think of the Humanae Vitae, there is no doubt that the worries and concerns that Pope Paul VI had, have come to fruition in our world.
