Peoples Ponderings

During this month of August, we remember two Saints who died in Concentration Camps during the second world war - on the 9th August - St Teresa Benedicta of the Cross (Edith Stein) and on 14th August St Maximilian Kolbe. These two Martyr saints remind us yearly of the horrors of the concentration camps and how much evil human beings can do to each other. It is important that we learn from the mistakes of the past and to realise that the Holocaust didn't happen overnight, but a propaganda war was waged first, dehumanising the Jews and saying there not the same as the rest of society. We can already see in some comments by politicians in America and here in the UK, the demonising of communities, even to the extent to what women choose to wear. We must stand up for the dignity of all human beings and the freedom of religion which we currently enjoy.

> First they came for the Jews and I did not speak out because I was not a Jew. Then they came for the Communists and I did not speak out because I was not a Communist. Then they came for the trade unionists and I did not speak out because I was not a trade unionist. Then they came for me and there was no one left to speak out for me.
