It is good to back after my summer holiday and I feel refreshed as I approach the start of my second year with you. While away, I switched off from parish life with just the occasional glance at emails, but with things like Twitter and Facebook it was impossible to switch off from the current crisis in the Church. I am sure that many of you are aware of the report issued in America regarding clerical abuse and the debates which have continued since. This became more heated with the issuing of the letter by Archbishop Vigano the former Papal Nuncio to the USA. In his letter he called on high ranking clergy to resign, including Pope Francis. A mere parish priest in Scunthorpe obviously doesn't know the ins and outs of the Church in America but the revelations/accusations have certainly shocked and concerned me. Many people are now understandably considering walking away from the Church but I was encouraged by something Bishop Robert Barron said – we are called to fight for the Church that we love, we are Catholic because of God, the Virgin Mary, the Saints, the Sacraments – not the Priests and Bishops. So let's pray for each other as the Church goes through this turbulent time, that we all keep hold of our Faith and to believe the words of Christ 'I am with you until the end of time'.

".....I wish you to know and for you to be able to say to your parishioners – that I personally share that shame and sorrow, and that I am praying for all the victims. Alongside you, I am committed to ensuring that any issues raised in this Diocese will be dealt with immediately and appropriately'.
