

19th Sunday in Ordinary Time

Reflection: Matthew 14:22-33

The Christian people is often depicted as a boat, with Peter at the helm. As in a boat, everyone has their part to play; kids to bring excitement and the challenge, parents to take the responsibility, grandparents just to be there to comfort and reassure. Without Jesus they were getting exhausted, frustrated and probably bad-tempered and quarrelling. When Jesus appears, everything changes; first, terror and awed amazement, then Peter rushes to meet him – and loses confidence, only to be swiftly rescued. How does Jesus come to me? In the unwelcome criticism of any angry neighbour who tells me the truth about myself? In the worries of a job or the agonies of a failed relationship? In the staggering beauty of creation? In physical pain? All these can bring God's presence, and without that presence we cannot expect to cope. Jesus does not force himself upon us. He just jogs, and says, "Here I am if you want me." He may disappear into the sea-mist again for a time, and we may sink into the water like mistrustful Peter. But it all ends with a welcome and a recognition that Jesus can cope even with a life-threatening situation. (HW)

Celebration of Mass

- ⇒ When planning to come to Mass, if you have booked, please be aware that you may be asked to wait outside until invited in to take a seat.
- ⇒ Please arrive in time to allow for this managed arrival to take place and for Mass to start on time.
- ⇒ Stewards will assist with arriving and leaving Church so that people are kept safe.
- ⇒ Singing: the Government guidance stresses that singing is to be 'specifically avoided'.
- ⇒ Distribution of Holy Communion: Communion is to be given hand to hand only and that social distancing is to be maintained with people moving within the space. This is only a necessary temporary emergency measure and, as soon as is possible, we will revert to our usual Canonical practice of offering people the choice of receiving Holy Communion either on the hand or on the tongue.
- ⇒ Please do not congregate in the Church or outside of the Church outside of your household group.
- ⇒ Please do follow all the necessary guideline and instructions – they have been put in place to ensure your safety and the safety of all in our communities.
- ⇒ Further information will be made available when arriving at Mass.
