## Changes to COVID-19 Restrictions from Monday 19th July 2021

From Monday 19th July many of the current restrictions will be lifted in our Churches in line with the new guidance from the Catholic Bishops' Conference of England and Wales published yesterday. This guidance brings to an end the official social distancing arrangements and there are no longer restrictions on the numbers attending Church for Baptisms, Weddings or Funerals.

Unfortunately, the Covid pandemic is not yet over and we need to take into consideration the local prevailing conditions in North Lincolnshire as restrictions are lifted for public acts of worship to return to normal practice. We will consider the guidance we have received and provide a fuller update in next week's newsletter. We will also include details regarding the opening of St Bernadette's Parish Centre and Holy Souls' Parish Hall.

### In the meantime from Monday 19th July:

- ⇒ The Sunday Obligation continues to be suspended.
- ⇒ You will no longer be required to pre-book a seat for a weekend Mass on the massbooking.co.uk website.
- ⇒ We will be returning the pews to the normal seating arrangements and continue to open windows and doors to provide good ventilation during services.
- ⇒ There will no longer be a one-way system operating in our churches.
- ⇒ You will be able to choose where you sit.

We are aware that some of us may still be anxious about coming into public buildings, therefore, we encourage the following:

- ⇒ **To not come to Church if you have any symptoms of Covid-19 or have been asked to self-isolate**
- ⇒ Scan the QR code in the church entrance for NHS Test, Track and Trace purposes.
- ⇒ Sanitise your hands when entering and leaving Church.
- ⇒ Wear a face covering unless you are exempt from doing so.
- ⇒ That, where possible, you try to leave two seats space between you and other people not known to you.
- ⇒ When moving to receive Holy Communion, please avoid getting too close to the person in front of you.
