#### Consultation on Sunday Mass Times

It is long overdue that we, the Parish of the Lincolnshire Martyrs, should have a proper consultation about Sunday Mass times. You will remember that Fr Michael Gilligan suddenly resigned as parish priest of Brigg and Barton a year and a half ago. This meant that we lost our assistant priest, Fr Limnyuy, at very short notice. Then there was no time for a proper consultation on Mass time changes and I simply had to take a decision on which Mass times would best serve the needs of the area, and be manageable for me. Now that we are a combined parish, I would like to hold a consultation at all Sunday Masses next weekend (15th/16th February). This will take place at the end of Mass and be in the form of a written survey with a few questions for each person to answer. Hopefully it will only take five minutes to complete and return. For those who will not be here, the consultation form will be available for two weeks at the back of church. After this the result will be announced. In order to allow you plenty of time to consider your choice the potential Mass times are as follows:

On **Saturday evening** for the vigil Mass at St Bernadette's there are three possible options:

- 6.00 pm
- 4.30 pm in the winter changing to 6.00 pm in British Summer Time

On **Sunday mornings**, given our geography and the fact that there is only one priest, there are really only three viable op-

I have decided to leave the Vigil Mass at St Bernadette's as it is working well. I have ruled the possibility of a Sunday evening Mass out because this would be too much for me on my own. Remember that in Canon Law I am only allowed to say three Masses on Sunday and one on a Saturday evening. This is partly to protect the priest's own reverence for the Mass and also to allow for the fact that a priest does many other things at the weekend in addition to saying Mass, such as baptisms, weddings, funeral receptions, dealing with enquiries, administration, homily preparation, calls to the sick, etc. The priest must also have some time to himself to pray and to rest on a Sunday.

I invite you to consider the above options and make your choice on the form available at the back of our Churches.
