**Consultation on Sunday Mass Times**

The potential Mass times are as follows:

On **Saturday evening** for the vigil Mass at St Bernadette's there are three possible options:

- ♦ 4.30 pm
- ♦ 6.00 pm
- ♦ 4.30 pm in the winter changing to 6.00 pm in British Summer Time

On **Sunday mornings**, given our geography and the fact that there is only one priest, there are really only three viable options:

- ♦ The current position 8.30 am St Norbert's, 10.00 am Holy Souls, 11.30 am St. Bernadette's
- ♦ 8.00 am St Bernadette's, 9.30 am St Norbert's, 11.00 am Holy Souls
- ♦ 8.00 am St Bernadette's, 9.30 am Holy Souls, 11.00 am St Norbert's

I have decided to leave the Vigil Mass at St Bernadette's as it is working well. I have ruled the possibility of a Sunday evening Mass out because this would be too much for me on my own. Remember that in Canon Law I am only allowed to say three Masses on Sunday and one on a Saturday evening. This is partly to protect the priest's own reverence for the Mass and also to allow for the fact that a priest does many other things at the weekend in addition to saying Mass, such as baptisms, weddings, funeral receptions, dealing with enquiries, administration, homily preparation, calls to the sick, etc. The priest must also have some time to himself to pray and to rest on a Sunday.

I invite you to consider the above options and make your choice on the form available at the back of our Churches.
