The Results of the Consultation on Sunday Mass times

In total 469 ballot papers were returned, which is a very positive response to the consultation. I would like to thank all those who took part. The results were as follows:

103 people said they mostly attended the Saturday vigil Mass at St Bernadette's. Of these:

- 58%, or 59 people, said they would prefer to keep the Mass time as it is at 6.00 pm, all year round.
- 21%, or 22 people, said they would like a 4.30 pm vigil mass all year round.
- The remaining 21% (22 people) would have preferred to have a 6.00 pm Mass in British Summer Time and a 4.30 pm Mass in British Winter Time.

357 people said they mostly attended Mass on Sunday morning. Of these:

- 72% (257 people) said they would prefer to keep the Sunday Masses as they are (8.30 am St Norbert's, 10.00 am Holy Souls and 11.30 am at St Bernadette's).
- 15% (54 people) said they would have preferred an 8.00 am Mass at St Bernadette's, 9.30 am Mass at St Norbert's and 11.00 am Mass at Holy Souls.
- 13% (46 people) said they would prefer an 8.00 am Mass at St Bernadette's, 9.30 am at Holy Souls, and 11.00 am at

Therefore, the people of this parish have told me that we should keep all Sunday Mass times as they are at present in no uncertain terms.

realise that the current mass schedule will not be perfect for everyone, but it is the best we can do at the present time. May I encourage those of you who would prefer a different Mass time to consider travelling to a different church in the parish, or even beyond, from time to time. Many of you are already doing this. Given the shortage of priests, we cannot all have the Mass time we would like in the church we would like.

Just as your parish priest has had to be flexible in making changes to his life in order to come to Scunthorpe to serve you, 🕻 you too could be a little more flexible. This could be your way of sharing in the difficulties the local Church is experiencng in terms of a shortage of vocations to the priesthood.
