Canon Matthew's Catechism

Prayer as Communion

In the New Covenant formed by the death and Resurrection of Christ, prayer is the living relationship of the disciple of Christ with the Father, the Son and the Holy Spirit. St Gregory Nazianzus tells us that the grace given us is "the union of the entire and royal Trinity with the whole human spirit." We are called to union with the Trinity and this relationship is referred to as a communion. This communion is possible because we have already been united with Christ at baptism. (CCC 2565)
