The Pope's Prayer Intention - April 2025

For the use of the new technologies. Let us pray that the use of the new technologies will not replace human relationships, will respect the dignity of the person and will help us face the crises of our times.



Canon Matthew's Catechism on Prayer

Prayer in the Old Testament (CCC 2568-2571)

At the time of Seth and Enosh man began to call on the holy name of God (Gen 4.26). Enoch lived 365 years and he "walked with God". Because he "walked with God" (this is a way of describing prayer) God assumed him into heaven (Gen 5.24). This kind of righteous prayer, or "walking with God", is practised by righteous people in all religions. After the flood God establishes a covenant with every living creature (Gen 9:8-16). God has always called people to prayer but it is with Abraham that prayer is especially revealed in the Old Testament. Abraham listens to God's word and in obedience leaves his country (Gen 12:4). He is a man of silence who prays without words, constructing altars to the Lord at each stage of his journey. Abraham's first vocal prayer is to remind God that he hasn't fulfilled his promise to give him an heir (Gen 15: 2-3). Abraham offers hospitality to three angels in his tent, foreshadowing the revelation of the Holy Trinity (Gen 18:1-15). After God has confided his plans to Abraham, he dares to intercede on behalf of Sodom and Gomorrah with bold confidence (Gen 18:16-33).
