### Sts Martha, Mary and Lazarus ~ 29th July

This feast in honour of Martha, Mary and Lazarus of Bethan is now celebrated on the octave day, the eighth day of the feas of St Mary Magdalene. It is fortunate that all three intimate friends of Jesus, Martha, Mary and Lazarus, are honoured to gether now in a common feast, thanks to the liturgical innovation of our late and dearly loved Pope Francis. The Church's tradition emphasizes that Martha served Iesus and his disciples by offering them hospitality. She is therefore seen as an example of the active, working Christian, living in the world. She is also the patron of innkeepers and all who work in the hospitality industry. Jesus mildly rebuked Martha for not being like her sister, and being more attentive to his teachings, instead of being so busy. St Lazarus was raised from the dead, as a foretaste of the divine power which would break forth at the Ressleep the sleep of peace, and rise again at the end of time. In the office of readings St Augustine says:

"Our Lord's words to Martha teach us that though we labour among the many distractions of the world, we should have but one goal. For we are but travellers on a journey without as yet a fixed abode; we are on our way, not yet in our native land: we are in a state of longing, not yet of enjoyment. But let us continue on our way, and continue without sloth or respite, so that we may ultimately arrive at our destination."
