School admissions

to Catholic Secondary Academies (Year 7)

Children born between 01/09/2014 and 31/08 2015. The deadline for submitting your application for a school place is 31 October 2025. Application forms are available on your 'home' Local Authority website. For every Catholic school you apply for if you wish your child to be considered and ranked under a faith criterion you *should also complete a supplementary information form*, and return this form to the school by the deadline, (forms are available from the LA and the school). You **must** also include the supporting *evidence** as required with this form, eg baptism certificate (photocopies acceptable). Failure to supply the required supporting evidence will mean your child is ranked in a lower criterion which may affect your chance of a place.

**If you do not have the required evidence please contact the parish where your child was baptised for a copy certificate in good time [please note a fee may be charged for this].*

November - Month of The Holy Souls

November is traditionally the month when we remember deceased family and friends.

If you wish your loved ones to be remembered at Mass, please put your offering in a "November Dead List" envelope (available at the back of our Churches). The envelope can be placed in the collection basket as you leave Church and they will be placed in front of the Altar at all November Masses.

Blessing of Graves

This year the blessing of graves at Brumby will be on Saturday 1st November at 3.00 pm and at Woodlands on Sunday 2nd November at 3.00 pm.

We will pray the Rosary for the departed as usual, then Canon Matthew will bless holy water, say a prayer to bless the graves and ask those participating to take the holy water to bless the graves.

Please bring a bottle for holy water. For those who don't remember to bring a bottle, holy water bottles will be available for a small donation.

The usual plenary indulgence is available for prayers for the dead in a cemetery 1st to 8th November, on the usual conditions of Sacramental Confession, reception of Holy Communion and prayers for the Holy Father's intentions. The Indulgence is applicable to either the person themselves or the faithful departed.
