<u>Canon's Quote of the Week:</u>
"There was no room for them in the inn". Prayerful reflection over these words has highlighted an inner parallel between this saying and the profoundly moving words from St John's Prologue: "He came to his own home, and his own people received him not" (1:11). For the Saviour of the world, for him in whom all things were created (Col.1.16) there was no room. "Foxes have holes, and birds of the air have nests; but the Son of Man has no where to lay his head." (Mt 8.20). He who was crucified outside the city (Heb 13:12) also came into the world outside the city. This should cause us to reflect points towards the reversal of values found in the figure of Jesus Christ and his message. From the moment of his birth, he belongs outside the realm of what is important and powerful in worldly terms. Yet it is this unimportant and powerless child who proves to be the truly powerful one, the one or whom ultimately everything depends."

School admissions to Catholic Primary Academies

(Reception Year)
Children born between 01/09/2021 and 31/08/2022. The deadline for submitting an application for a school place is 15th January 2026. Application forms are available on your 'home Local Authority website. For every Catholic school you apply for if you wish your child to be considered and ranked under a faith criterion you should also complete a supplementary information form, and return this form to the school by the deadline, (forms are available from the LA and the school). You must also include the supporting evidence* as required with this form, ie a baptism certificate (photocopies are acceptable; contact the parish of baptism if you don't have a copy but please note there may be a charge for this); failure to supply the required supporting evidence will mean your child is ranked in a lower criterion which may affect your chance of a place.
