**Saints John Fisher and Thomas More**  
**Feast 22nd June**

This feast honours two martyrs of the English Reformation, who both died in 1535, a few days apart from one another. This feast is placed on the martyrdom of St John Fisher. John Fisher was born in Yorkshire in 1469. He had a distinguished academic career at Cambridge and was ordained at the age of 25. At the age of 35 he became the Bishop of Rochester. He was a friend of Erasmus, who said of him "There is not a man more cultured, more admired or more holy." He refused to take the oath of loyalty after the King married Anne Boleyn and rejected papal authority. He was beheaded a month after Pope Paul III named him cardinal. Thomas More was born in London and was twice married and was a member of Parliament. He was an outstanding humanist who wrote the Utopia, a book of political philosophy. He became Chancellor to Henry VIII. He opposed the king's remarriage and after three years resigned as Chancellor, refusing to recognise the King's spiritual supremacy. He was beheaded on July 6th 1535. Before his death, Thomas More wrote to his daughter "Nothing can come but what God wills. And I am very sure that whatever that be, however bad it may seem, it shall indeed be best."
