Hello from Lukas Mickevičius

"Praise be to the Lord Jesus Christ. My name is Lukas Mickevičius and I'm training to be a priest in our Diocese of Nottingham. I'll be staying at St Bernadette's with Canon Mat-thew until 24th July. In this time I hope to get to know you, the parishioners here in and around Scunthorpe, and for you to get to know me as - God willing - a future priest who may be serving you.

"To start us off, here's a little background on who I am. I was born and grew up in Lithuania, where most of my family still are. I was baptised a Catholic when I was a baby and received First Holy Communion in primary school. I came to England when I was sixteen to attend a boarding school in Wiltshire. I came to the Diocese when I was accepted to study Biochemis-try at the University of Nottingham. Over my four-year course I returned to attending Sunday Holy Mass, received Holy Con-firmation and began discerning the Sacred Priesthood. A few months after graduating I applied to study for the Priesthood and happily I was accepted. Since then, I have studied in Spain and am now two years a seminarian in St Mary's College Oscott, Birmingham.

"I hope that's enough for now for you to go on, but please come and speak to me after Holy Mass when I'd be glad to talk about anything I've mentioned above. Please keep me and all my brother seminarians in your prayers and be assured of mine for your parish. May God remain always with you. With prayers. Lukas."

Second Collection This Weekend

The life of a seafarer is a mix of hard work, long separations from family and the resilience to face unpredictable seas. A typical contract for those who call the ocean their workplace lasts several months, often with limited internet access, while working in shifts around the clock. It is a profession built on discipline, sacrifice, and the hope of a better future for one's family.

Life as a seafarer is not always smooth sailing. Isolation, ex-haustion, anxiety, and uncertainty can weigh heavily on those who work far from home and community. This is why the work of Stella Maris is so important. Through chaplains and ship visitors, Stella Maris offers pastoral, practical and spiritual support, friendship and a listening ear to seafarers and fish-ers in ports around the world. A simple visit can remind someone that they are not forgotten. A conversation, a prayer, or help contacting family can become a source of hope in dif-ficult times.

In today's Gospel the seed must die before it comes to life, and it is helped with the rain and the sun. Those at sea must leave family and home in order for their loved ones to remain. This Sea Sunday we too can play our part as the Sowers of the seed by putting our faith into action by supporting the seafarers who grace our shores.

Boilers at St Bernadette's Church

The new boilers have now been installed in the Church and in the Parish Centre.
