### Week of Prayer for Christian Unity - 18th to 25th January 2016

Our local Churches in North Scunthorpe (CINS) invite you all to an Ecumenical Service to celebrate the Week of Prayer for Christian Unity at St George's on Frodingham Road on Sunday 24th January at 5.30 pm. **Evensong at Lincoln Cathedral:** We have all been invited to attend Evensong at Lincoln Cathedral on Sunday 24th January 2016 where Bishop Patrick will be preaching. The Service, which falls during the Week of Prayer for Christian Unity, begins at 3.45 pm.

Thank you to everyone who attended the meeting on Tuesday evening to discuss the 'Jubilee of Mercy'. Although we were relatively few in number we had a good discussion not least noting the many 'works of mercy' that we are already involved in.

We decided to focus on the different works of mercy throughout the year highlighting ways in which people could get involved. This could be through giving time, money, or specific items. We will begin this process soon. During the 'Jubilee of Mercy' we will use the money that is collected in the retiring collections at the end of Mass in order to support works of mercy. This weekend we will look to support parishes that have been affected by the recent floods.

As well as the Diocesan Prayer that we have been using another prayer commended to us by Pope Francis is the 'Hail Holy Queen, Mother of Mercy' and also the Divine Mercy devotion. We hope to use appropriate opportunities throughout the year to learn more about these.

As well as my parish duties I have spent time this week learning more about the response of the Church to human trafficking and also meeting with colleagues from the Dioceses of Lincoln (Anglican), Brugge (Catholic) and Harnosand (Church of Sweden) to further our ecumenical relationships.
