This Week

Sea Sunday - This weekend in Sea Sunday, when the Church prays for all those who live and work at sea. We welcome Steven Willows from the Apostleship of the Sea who will be with us at the 9.30 am and 6.30 pm Masses on Sunday. A second collection will be taken.

Confirmation Programme - A reminder that for the next two sessions we will split up into parish groups and candidates from Holy Souls should come to Holy Souls on Mondays 11th and 18th July at the usual time.

Luddington - The Diocesan Property Department have given their consent to one further celebration of Mass at St Joseph's, Luddington, after which public worship will be suspended for reasons of health and safety pending a definitive decision on the future of the church and the site. Mass will be celebrated on Friday 15th July at 7.00 pm and will be offered in thanksgiving for graces and blessings received over the past 139 years.

It will also ensure that the parents will be able to take part in a baptism preparation evening the next one of which will take place after the summer holidays probably during the month of September.

Canon's Ramblings

If you have ever had reason to write to the Diocesan Curial Offices you will have seen that the address is 'Willson House', but have you ever wondered who exactly they are named after? On 30th June I attended a Mass at the Cathedral to pray for Bishop Willson on the 150th anniversary of his death. Robert Willson was born in Lincoln, and he was ordained a priest and served in Nottingham taking responsibility for the construction for the church of St Barnabas in 1844 which would a few years later become the Cathedral of the Diocese of Nottingham. However Fr Willson had in the meantime been appointed Bishop of Hobart, Tasmania, and there he worked hard especially on behalf of prisoners who had been transported there and who laboured under harsh conditions in the penal colonies. Thanks to his efforts transportation to Australia ceased to be a punishment for criminal offences. He is a true 'apostle of mercy' and an example and inspiration for us in this Year of Mercy. May he rest in peace.
