### Canon's Ramblings

This week is Holy Week, the most important week of the Liturgical Year.

On Wednesday Bishop Patrick will celebrate the Chrism Mass at the Cathedral in Nottingham a great gathering of people from across the Diocese during which our priests will renew their ordination promises and the oils that will be used in the Sacraments over the coming year will be blessed and consecrated. It is good that some of our parishioners will be present as well as our clergy.

Maundy Thursday sees the Mass of the Lord's Supper which recalls the institution of the Eucharist and the Lord's example of service in washing his disciples feet. We will be looking for volunteers to have a foot washed.

On Good Friday we recall the Lord's passion and death principally in our Liturgy at 3.00 pm but also by making the Stations of the Cross on the High Street in the morning together with members of other local Churches.

On the evening of Holy Saturday we gather for the Easter Vigil, in which we light the Easter fire and candle, listen to an extended liturgy of the word, renew our baptismal promises, and then celebrate the first Mass of Easter.

All of the above are wonderful occasions and it would be a shame if you missed them all and only came to church on Easter Sunday. Even if you have not attended the ceremonies in the past, why not make a special effort to join us this year.
